On May 21, 2007, at the Center for Strategic and International Studies, Guy Caruso - Administrator of the U.S. Department of Energy's Energy Information Administration - will release the agency's *International Energy Outlook 2007 (IEO2007)*. The latest edition of this annual publication includes projections of world energy demand by region and primary energy source through 2030; electricity generation by fuel type; and energy-related carbon dioxide emissions. This year's report highlights the effects of robust economic growth in China and India on international fuel markets, the likely future levels of OPEC and non-OPEC oil production, the expected global gains for coal in the power generation sector, and the increase in carbon emissions associated with growing energy consumption.
